

#### OC ECONOMIC RECOVERY UPDATE

Given the continued economic shutdown mandated by Sacramento, Supervisor Wagner and his colleagues on the Board of Supervisors allocated \$10 million from the County's General Fund for additional Small Business Grants. This made \$2 million available for Third District businesses. In Supervisor Wagner's continuing effort to facilitate local control, and because he believes that the Mayors and cities know their needs better than the County, Supervisors Wagner made that \$2 million available to each city, based on that particular city's Third District population, in the form of grants to small businesses.

Supervisor Wagner had previously allocated \$15 million in 2020 to the cities to conduct small business grant programs. That \$15 million was from the CARES Act, whereas this \$2 million is from the General Fund.



ORANGE, CA — Six-year-old Aiden Leos was fatally shot on the 55 freeway in Orange on his way to kindergarten at Calvary Chapel in Yorba Linda.

A <u>memorial service</u> was held for Aiden Leos on Saturday at Calvary Chapel Yorba Linda. His mother, Joanna Cloonan, expressed gratitude to the community: "Your kindness, your prayers, your support, and unbelievable generosity has helped provide me with so much strength, so I may stand on my own two feet today, in front of you, and share the beauty of who Aiden was and still is."

She also said, "I want nothing more than to find justice, although it won't bring you back into our arms...It makes me outraged that such a precious beautiful soul did not get the opportunity to continue developing into a young man, and starting a family of his own one day while accomplishing his heart's desires. My precious son had his life ripped away from him for absolutely no reason."

One day after the service, the suspects were arrested. Marcus Anthony Eriz, 24, and Wynne Lee, 23, were taken into custody at their home in Costa Mesa on Sunday. By Tuesday, charges were brought forward by District Attorney Todd Spitzer. Eriz is eligible for a life sentence for murder and Lee is facing jail time for

accessory after the fact.

Supervisor Wagner's original offer to increase the family's reward gave the community an effort to get behind and played a role in keeping media attention on the case; CHP noted public participation and tips made the difference. At a press conference on



Tuesday, Supervisor Wagner said that was a testament to the people of Orange County who recognize that this sort of violence cannot be allowed to stand in our community.

Now, justice is in the capable hands of the District Attorney's Office and CHP, who led the investigation. Supervisor Wagner also gives a special thank you to OC District Attorney Todd Spitzer and CHP for their tireless work on cracking this case.

Supervisor Wagner's office is partnering with OC Parks to give a <u>dedication in the name</u> of Aiden Leos at OC Zoo's new Large Mammal Exhibit, which is currently under construction. A plaque in Aiden's name may help leave a legacy that inspires the people of Orange County to rally for justice, give support for victims of crime, and encourage the reporting of information that may solve a crime for another family.

This includes expectant women and their partners affected by the pregnancy or birth of a child within the past 12 months, families that have a history of Social Services involvement or families with a young child between the ages of 0 - 8 years who are exhibiting behavioral symptoms that may be negatively impacting their readiness for school.


